



# Weatherization Assistance Program Capstone Community Action

*Serving towns in Addison County, Lamoille County, Washington County,  
Orange County, Rutland County, and Windsor County*

## What is the Weatherization Assistance Program?

Capstone provides weatherization services, such as insulation and air sealing, **free of charge** to central Vermonters who meet income and other qualifications. Trained professionals will review the problem areas in your home and identify the most cost-effective steps that can be taken to increase comfort, reduce heat loss, and ensure safety. While actual savings vary for each home, most people end up saving \$400-\$700 a year!

## Who Should Apply?

You are eligible for weatherization services—whether you own or rent— if you meet one of the following:

- Your household income is at or below 80% of median income (see chart)

- Someone in your household gets Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Someone in your household is receiving or will receive Seasonal Fuel Assistance (LIHEAP)

### What You Will Need:

- Completed and signed application form – call to get one mailed to you or download from the website
- Proof of ownership (ex: copy of property tax bill) or landlord contact information (if you're renting)
- Types of fuel and fuel dealers used

### When to Apply:

- No deadline for applications – applications are prioritized by need

### Things to Know:

- Incomplete applications can result in delays. Get a head start by alerting your employer about income verification and obtaining proof of ownership in advance.
- Don't be discouraged if you are placed on a waiting list – free weatherization is worth the wait!
- Timeframe for project completion varies depending on the work needed, but projects are usually done in a few days once work begins. You can stay in your home, while work is being done.
- Homes for sale or that received no-cost weatherization since September 30, 2002, are not eligible.
