



# Energy Assistance Program Green Mountain Power

## What is Green Mountain Power's (GMP) Energy Assistance Program?

GMP Energy Assistance helps low-income Vermonters afford electricity for their homes. Eligible GMP customers can receive:

- 25% discount off their monthly charges for the energy used
- Arrears forgiveness if new to the program and owe on a past bill

## Who Should Apply?

To be eligible, you must:

1. Be a residential customer of Green Mountain Power and
2. Have a total **gross monthly household income** at or below [150% of the federal poverty level](#)

## How to Apply:

- Print the application form available online at [dcf.vermont.gov/benefits/eap/gmp](http://dcf.vermont.gov/benefits/eap/gmp) or call 800-775-0516 to ask that one be mailed to you. Leave a message if you get voicemail.
- Attach a copy of your most recent electric bill. Don't send an original bill.

## When to Apply:

- Applications are accepted year-round. Apply now and start saving on your electric bill!
- You **must reapply each year** to keep getting the discount.

**NOTE:** Once enrolled in the program, you must report any changes to your household income or household members by calling the Economic Services Division at 800-775-0516 within 10 business days. Failing to report changes will make you ineligible for the program and may result in legal action against you for discounts improperly received.
