



Home Performance with Energy Star Efficiency Vermont

What is Home Performance with Energy Star (HPwES)?

Home Performance with ENERGY STAR offers whole-house solutions to high energy bills and homes with comfort problems. Efficiency Vermont qualifies all contractors that participate in HPwES, independently verifies the quality of contractors' work, and reimburses homeowners for 50% of project cost, up to \$4,000. Homeowners can feel confident in their contractor's recommendations and in the effectiveness of the home improvements they pay for.

Who is Eligible?

Any household in Vermont can receive rebates of 50% of the project cost, up to \$2,000. Income-eligible Vermonters are eligible for an additional \$2,000 rebate (\$4,000 total). See chart to find out if you qualify for the additional rebate.

Project Eligibility:

- Eligible projects achieve minimum air leakage reduction of 10% (as measured by a pre- and post-blower-door test), and installation of all recommended health and safety improvements.
- Work must be performed by a participating Efficiency Excellence Network contractor.

How to Enroll

1. Confirm eligibility by calling Efficiency Vermont
2. Hire an [Efficiency Excellence Network contractor](#)
3. Complete an [enrollment form](#)
4. Work with your contractor to install qualified measures
5. Contractor reports completed work to Efficiency Vermont for review
6. Receive check in the mail within 60 days of reporting work completion to Efficiency Vermont
