What is the Weatherization Assistance Program?

Southeastern Vermont Community Action (SEVCA) provides weatherization services, such as insulation and air sealing, **free of charge** to Vermonters who meet income and other qualifications. Trained professionals will review the problem areas in your home and identify the most cost-effective steps that can be taken to increase comfort, reduce heat loss, and ensure safety.

Who Should Apply?

You are eligible for weatherization services—whether you own or rent— if you meet one of the following:

- Your household income is at or below 80% of median income (see chart)

- Someone in your household gets Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Someone in your household is receiving or will receive Seasonal Fuel Assistance (LIHEAP)

What You Will Need:

- Completed and signed application form – call to get one mailed to you or download from the website
- Proof of ownership (ex: copy of property tax bill) or landlord contact information (if you're renting)
- Types of fuel and fuel dealers used

When to Apply:

- No deadline for applications – applications are prioritized by need

Things to Know:

- Incomplete applications can result in delays. Get a head start by alerting your employer about income verification and obtaining proof of ownership in advance.
- Don't be discouraged if you are placed on a waiting list – free weatherization is worth the wait!
- Timeframe for project completion varies depending on the work needed, but projects are usually done in a few days once work begins. You can stay in your home while work is being done.
- Homes for sale or that received no-cost weatherization since September 30, 2002, are not eligible.

- Contact COVER Home Repair at 802-296-7241 for volunteer-assisted weatherization. Home must be within a 45-minute drive from White River Junction. No income restrictions apply.
