These grants will help your farm, food business or, restaurant defray the costs of vending at Flavors of the Valley on April 7th at Hartford High School.

The maximum mini-grant award is \$200. Any vendor that is a farm, food business or restaurant that is eligible to vend at Flavors of the Valley is eligible to apply for funds.

APPLICATION PROCESS: Applicants must complete the on-line application form by February 17th or you may fill out the form below and submit it electronically to Beth Roy at Beth@VitalCommunities.org by February 17th. Applications received by **February 17th**, will get first consideration, and thereafter applications will be considered on a rolling basis. Mini-grant applications will not be considered unless a complete vendor application and vendor fee has also been received by February 17th.

USE OF GRANT FUNDS: Grant funds may be used to offset the cost of vendor registration, food sample costs or, the cost of staffing the event.
