To get there: Take I-89 north to Waterbury. Follow Route 100 to Route 2 and turn left. Turn left again at Stowe Street. The Quest starts at the school on Stowe Street. Begin at the Civil War Monument on the front lawn. The Quest ends when you find the medicine bottle and stamp!

Clues:

1. Here at this stone
Find the name of the man
Who was the town's Doctor
And hero of this plan.
2. We're taking a walk
With Dr. Janes. In 1897
He came up to see
The School under construction.
3. Now turn to the west and
Walk down the street.
Cross the dry bridge.
On the right, the livery stable you'll meet.
4. Dr. Janes stopped to buy
Oats for his Morgan horse team.
He had a sick child
Who needed to be seen.

8. Now let's cross the Main Street
To the white Congregational Church.
Straight ahead is the school where
For more cases of flu he would search.

9. He looked at the bright colors
Of the new church windows' stain,
And listened for music
Of the church organ's refrain.

10. Dr. Janes gave money to purchase the windows here,
And when the church organ was lost in a fire
He loaned them the organ from his house—
Which we will discover is near.

11. Look up at the spire showing NESW.
And note the weather vane.
Turn yourself to the north
And continue on down the lane.

12. To find Dr. Janes' home
You must travel awhile.
Past Stage Coach Inn, Winooski Street,
Continue on, it's less than a mile.

13. On the left you'll discover
A library sign.
You're successful—this house
Was Dr. Janes' home at this time.

14. Now enter the library
Go up a flight of stairs.
You'll find Dr. Janes' medicine bag
And one of his chairs.

15. To the left of the glass case
Is Dr. Janes' traveling chest.
Peek behind to find the medicine bottle,
And the stamp to complete this Quest.
