



Bradford Memorial Quest

Bradford, Vermont

To get there: Take Interstate 91 North to Exit 16. Make a right onto Route 25. At the traffic light, make a left turn onto Route 5 North. As you come to a bridge and cross the Waits River, you'll see a waterfall on your left. Park in the lot just beyond the falls.

Please note: This Quest can be only be completed Tuesdays 9-2, Wednesdays 12-8, Thursday 12-8, Friday 10-5 and Saturday 9-2.

Clues:


To find your treasure gather letters and numbers, and fill them into the numbered spaces.

1. Begin this quest.....
Where the water falls.
2. There are three benches:
The "Last word" on one is a number. Put that into space #20.
3. Put the last letter from the middle bench in space #1.
4. Take the first letter of the final bench and put that into space #8.
5. Now look for a "memorial rock". Take the first letter from each first name: the first of the first goes in #13; the first of the second goes into #10.
6. Look across the street for "The Mill," then look high for a number.
The third of four goes into space #19.

7. Walk north on the sidewalk. At the end, cross carefully to the other side, as indicated on the map.
8. Look for a cluster of signs. From the first word on the top sign, take the 3rd letter and put it in #9.
9. From the second word on the top sign take the first letter and put that in #14.
10. Look at the second word on the sign below. The last letter of this nine letter word goes in #15.
11. Look across the street for two memorials. Cross carefully to get there.
12. Go to the monument. Look at the first two dates. One number appears four times. A second number appears twice. Take that 2nd number and put it into space #17.
13. Look at the four sides of this monument. How many Bradford citizens served in the Civil War? The third digit of this number _ _ _ goes into space #21.
14. Now, who is that big statue? This person's title is made up of two words. The first letter of the first word goes into #12.
15. The first letter of the second word goes in space #3.
16. What state was this person born in? The 1st letter of that state goes into space #16.
17. How many letters are in the first name of this person? That number goes into #18.
18. Go to the building that looks like a castle. Look above the entry to find the name of this building. The 3rd letter of the name of the person this building is named for goes in space #6.
19. The fourth letter of this person's name goes in space #4.

20. Finally, the first letter of the third word goes in #11.
21. Now, go into this place and look for the special number that is indicated. If you need help, there is someone here who can help you.
