To get there: This Quest begins at the Plainfield Cemetery. It is located about 7 miles south of Lebanon on the east side of Route 12A. It is just south of Stage Road and about 1/4 mile north of Plainfield Village and Daniels Rd.

Clues:

The view of Ascutney looks the best when you're facing the southwest.

Go in to town towards the gray building where kids were taught.

Now it's a place where antiques are bought.

It used to be in a shed behind the town hall and firemen leave there when they get a call.

Continue south to the brick building and that's how it looks #1088 is its location. It has lots of books.

It's a brick building where lightning hit the steeple in 1948 and scared all the people.

South some more, go to the raspberry and pink store—buying things is what it's for.

Now arrange to go the grange.

Cross the street where a hurricane blew in 1938.

That's why the windows are bricked in. Don't be late!

Go northeast to where Maxfield Parrish's back drop must hang (Open Sunday afternoons in summer.)

and have an old town meeting with the selectmen and gang.

Go to the clubhouse where the Mothers' and Daughters' met.

Rugs were woven and historical artifacts are set.

Kingsbury tavern is up on the hill.

If you run into Aunt Ester's ghost, you might get a chill.

Now for the final place on your map,
go to the place where the spirits take a nap.
Lastly, look along the wall made of rocks near the hitching post. Don't
