Bring: Field Guide

*From White River Junction, head west (toward Woodstock) on Route 4. This Quest begins at the Fat Hat Corner plaza on your right, as you head toward Quechee.*

#### Clues:

1. If you look around, you will always find a clue!
2. These buildings now sell lots of stuff,  
But once, farming here was quite enough.
3. This small food building, where you stand as a group;  
It was once a chicken coop.
4. Now make your way to the path back by the barn,  
There another clue to earn.
5. A colorful bus whose travel days are over.  
It is parked here for forever.
6. Next, Up the hill you go with screened hut on the right  
Where people can be safe from bugs at night.
7. Further along the right, apple trees are clues  
That this place was an old homestead, too.
8. Stay left in the open meadow  
For the woods trail is where I want you to go.

9. A stump! Another clue! Lo...what does this mean?  
That once upon a time here a logger could be seen.
10. A stone wall! Now there is your key  
That fields and pastures this once would be.
11. Now we enter into a shady place  
Where beech trees this place do grace.
12. Just before the fork (and the fern clearing)  
The last 2 clues I want you to be hearing.
13. Nearby right, look for a tree blown down.  
Its upturned roots look like a green, hairy mound.
14. If you circle carefully, and look around  
Your Quest treasure box will certainly be found.
